Are you an entrepreneur who would benefit from being a case study presenter?

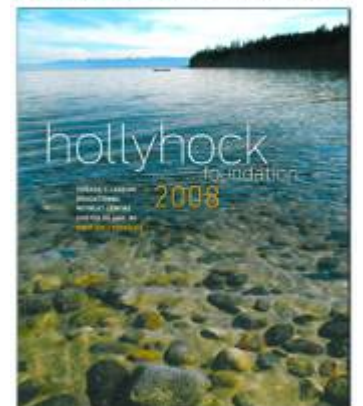
Case study presenters receive invaluable advice specific to their challenges from experts in the field.
